- There was a discussion on the subject of applying for social security disability. One patient applied in January 2005 but was only successful in receiving the benefit in September 2008. Another member commented that in order to be successful you need to be well prepared and have good documentation from your doctor. Of the members who have applied in the organization, most cases have gone to appeal. The more information we are able to share on this subject, the easier it may be for future requestors. It was suggested that it would be good if the organization had a volunteer to collate the documentation that patients would need when applying for social security disability. The Social Security Office now has a program called 'Fast Track' (<http://www.socialsecurity.gov/pressoffice/pr/fast-track-disability-process-pr.htm>) and if a patient has one of the diseases on the fast track list, the approval process is much quicker. It would be useful to look into what would be required to get ECD onto this fast track list.
