Call for Letters of Intent – 2025 ECD Research Funding Opportunity

Advancing Research in Erdheim-Chester Disease and Adult Histiocytic Disorders

Early Career Investigators Encouraged to Apply

The Erdheim-Chester Disease Global Alliance (ECDGA) invites Letters of Intent (LOI) for research projects focused on **Erdheim-Chester Disease (ECD)** and related **adult histiocytic disorders**. We welcome proposals that aim to advance scientific understanding and improve patient outcomes.

Grant Details:

- **Funding Amount:** Up to \$60,000 USD
- **Duration:** 2 years
- **LOI Deadline:** September 23, 2025
- **Eligibility:** Early Career Investigators (international submissions welcome)

Eligibility Criteria:

Early Career Investigators are individuals who:

- Are within ten (10) years of completing a terminal research degree or postdoctoral training, or of completing medical residency/fellowship (or equivalent)
- Have not previously received an ECDGA Early Career Investigator Grant

Proposal Focus:

LOIs must include a clear explanation of how the proposed research will benefit ECD patients. Strong consideration will be given to projects that:

- Involve cross-institutional collaboration
- Aim to translate findings to clinical settings
- Utilize the ECD Patient Registry at Memorial Sloan Kettering (PI: Dr. Eli Diamond, diamone1@mskcc.org)
