Thank you for your incredible support throughout 2024. Thanks to your generosity, the Erdheim-Chester Disease Global Alliance (ECDGA) has experienced significant program growth, an expanded global community, and funded essential research to help pave the way for a brighter future for ECD patients.

Support: Empowering the ECD Community

In 2024, the Patient Navigator program, provided personalized support to 84 new patients, bringing the total number of families served to 1,020 across 75 countries. The Peer-to-Peer Chats were expanded to include more languages (Spanish, French, German, and Italian). Also introduced were location-specific chats tailored for ECD community



members in Australia, New Zealand, and Canada. In addition, regular caregiver chats are now available.

ECD Referral Care Center Network

The ECD Referral Care Center Network is available to help patients find knowledgeable doctors to confirm a diagnosis and to provide treatments and ongoing care. The establishment and growth of the Care Center Network helps patients find a medical team with interest and knowledge in treating people living with ECD and other adult histiocytic disorders.

Today there are 41 Care Centers in 17 countries, with three new centers joining the network in 2024. The new 2024 Care Centers are located in Dijon, France; Riyadh, Saudi Arabia; and Dallas, TX USA. All ECD Care Centers provide invaluable access to specialized care and support for people living with ECD and other histiocytic disorders.

Awareness: Raising Visibility of ECD

In 2024, ECD staff and volunteers attended Medical Specialty Conferences for pathology, endocrinology, radiology, and ophthalmology to raise awareness and educate medical professionals on recognizing the signs of ECD and diagnosing it earlier in the progression of the disease.





People from around the world participated in the 2024 ECD Awareness Week. One highlight was the hugely successful Fun Run/Walk/Roll, which set a new worldwide participation record. More than \$22,000 was raised to support the ECDGA's mission while raising ECD awareness in communities across the globe!

Over 110 medical professionals, scientists, patients, family members, and other interested individuals came together to share their knowledge and experience related to ECD.



Research: Advancing Treatments for ECD

The ECDGA proudly awarded a \$50,000 grant to Dr. Francesco Peyronel at Meyer Children's University Hospital in Firenze, Italy. This research is focused on developing a comprehensive tool to predict ECD patient prognosis and the risk of other disease-related consequences.

Thanks to the generosity of our donors, the ECDGA has funded more than \$1.2 million for ECD research to help better understand the disease and improve patient outcomes.
