- 1. Visit www.erdheimchester.org/resources

- 4. If you need a printed copy, please note that in the field, "Please tell us how we can best help you."



- 5. Check your email for a digital copy of your brochure(s).
- 6. If you requested a paper copy, it will arrive via U.S. Postal Service.

IDEAS for sharing ECD brochures.

Sharing brochures helps raise awareness—and could help others get diagnosed earlier. Some ideas for sharing brochures include:

💾 1. With Medical Professionals

Bring a brochure to your next medical appointment. Hand it to your doctor, nurse, or tech and say something like:

"Since I have ECD (or my loved one does), I wanted to share this brochure with you. It's a quick read, and I'd really appreciate it if you'd take a look. Let me know if you have any questions after reading it!"

1 2. With Medical Institutions

Email or message local hospitals or medical centers. Try something like: "September 8–13 is Erdheim-Chester Disease Awareness Week. ECD is a rare histiocytic neoplasm, and I'd love to share brochures for any interested professionals at your institution. Can you tell me the best way to do this so the information reaches the right people?"

🞎 3. With Family and Friends

Many people want to know more but aren't sure how to ask. You might say: "You know I have ECD, and I thought you might have questions. This brochure explains more about the disease and what I'm dealing with. I'd be happy to talk if you want to learn more."
